"The friendships I've developed here were instant and are really deep," Alyce explained. "We are all in the same boat. Most of us left homes that we had lived in for decades. Many of us have lost a spouse or a special person in our lives. We have learned to let go of things that we once cherished."

Susie has also enjoyed "going deeper" in her relationship with her mother. "Previously," Susie said, "all our time was spent in 'visits.' Now we have the freedom to spend more time together on a spontaneous basis."

"I can't believe I'm in the same town as one of my daughters, and I have my grandchildren and great-grandchildren in my life on a daily basis," Alyce exclaimed. "I'm so happy I want to pinch myself."
